

## **ADMISSION IN T Y B A IN ENGLISH MEDIUM**

Gujarat Arts & Commerce College (Evening) Ahmedabad. Started with Arts Stream/Faculty in the year 1992. The medium of instruction in Arts stream in Gujarati.

There are 2 division in F.Y.B.A. [01 'A' Stream and 01 'B' Stream Division]

### **Principal / main Subjects :--**

### **Subsidiary Subjects :--**

Sanskrit, English, Gujarati, Hindi, Psychology, History, Economics, Sociology.

### **Important Conditions / criteria for Admission :--**

1. The candidate / student should have passed S.Y.B.A. Examinations, students who have A.T.K.T. in S.Y.B.A. are permitted to take admission in T.Y.B.A.
2. If a student belonging to a college affiliated to discuss to take admission in this college, she/he will have to obtain a provisional Eligibility certificate (PEC) otherwise she/he will not be allowed admission.
3. Student belonging to other college affiliated to another university who wish to take admission in this college are required to fill up the enrollment form and pay the required fees. This is compulsory and if the students fail to do so she/he will not be allowed to appear in the annual examination and his/her admission will be considered cancelled.

**Important conditions after having obtained Admission:-**

1. Students who come from other colleges of affiliated to other Universities and take admission in this college are required to fill the enrolment form of the University if this condition is not fulfilled the student will not be allowed to appear in the annual Examination and his/her admission will be considered as cancelled.  
While filling the student form, one attested copy of F.Y.B.Com. mark sheet of S.Y.B.A., two passport sized photographs and Gujarat University Provisional Eligibility certification (PEC) [wherever applicable] should be attached.
2. The attendance is compulsory and is regularly taken in the collage. The student whose attendance falls short of the required number set by the University will not be allowed to appear in college as well as University examinations.
3. For all work pertaining to admission, examination as other work, the student should personally contact the office during office hours.
4. It is compulsory to appear in the first and second term exam of the college. Only under rare and unavoidable circumstances which are beyond control, will the student be allowed to appear in the retest with pre-obtained permission of the Principal otherwise s/he will not be allowed to appear in Retest.
5. The fees of second term and University should be filled in the given time period / frame, else the admission will be cancelled.
6. She student in required to keep the college I-card with his/her person.

**Examination :-**

1. It is Compulsory to appear in the Internal Examination conducted by the college and the University Examination.

3. If the student obtains less than the required minimum marks in the Internal exam conducted by the college, it is called Internal Fail.
4. If he/she obtains less than 25 marks in the University Examination it is called External Fail.
5. If the Student in Internal Fail, then she/he is required to compulsorily appear in the University Exam of the subjects in which he/she is Internal fail.
6. It is compulsory for the Internal Fail Student to appear in the First and the second test of the college.
7. Those students who are declared fail in the University Examination cannot appear in the Examination conducted in the month of October-November. Such students can appear in the exam conducted by the University in the months of March-April. The form for this exam is available in the month of December. (Keep an eye on the notice board.)
