

## **ADMISSION IN T Y B COM IN ENGLISH MEDIUM**

In the year 1997 the commerce stream was started in Gujarat Arts & Commerce College (Evening) Ahmedabad. T.Y.B.Com. classes started in the year 1999. The Medium of instruction is in Gujarati Medium.

The Admission form of T.Y.B.Com is available at the College office at the Prescribed University fees.

Principal condition/criterion for admission :-

### **Important Condition for Admission**

1. The student should have passed F.Y.B.Com. and S.Y.B.Com. exams. Students with A.T.K.T. in S.Y.B.Com. are allowed to take admission in T.Y.B.Com. [If they have passed F.Y.B.Com.]
2. Student coming from another college affiliated to another University is required to obtain Provisional Eligibility Certificate. In the failure of doing so, the Student is not eligible for Admission.
3. Student belonging to other college affiliated to another University, who wish to take admission in this College are required to fill up the enrollment form and pay the required fees. This is compulsory and if the student fails to do so he/she will not be allowed to appear in the Annual Examination and his/her admission will be considered cancelled.

### **The Following Certificate/documents should be attached with the Admission form at the time of admission :--**

1. One attested copy & all the attempts of F.Y.B.Com. and S.Y.B.Com. Examination.
2. Two passport size photos.
3. Original Provisional Eligibility Certificate. [If applicable]

### **Important Condition other having obtained Admission: --**

1. Students coming from other college affiliated to other University, seeking admission in this College are required to fill up the Gujarat University enrollment form in the event of not doing so the University Exam and his/her admission will be considered cancelled while filling up the enrollment form attested copies of the mark sheet of F.Y.B.Com. and S.Y.B.Com. two passport size photographs attested copy of the provisional Eligibility certificate (PEC) of the University (If applicable) should be attached.
2. The attendance in compulsory and in regularly taken in the college Hence the student should attend lectures regularly. The student whose attendance falls short of the student required number set by the University will not be allowed to appear in college as well as University Examination.
3. For all work regularly pertaining to Admission Examination or other work the student should Personally contact the office during office house.
4. It is Compulsory to appear in the First and Second Term Exam of the college Only under rare and unavailable circumstance will the student be allowed to appear of the Retest With Pre-obtained permission assent of the Principal otherwise he/she will not be allowed to appear in the Retest.
5. The fees of the Second Term and University fee should be filled in the given time Period/frame, else the admission will be cancelled.
6. The student is required to keep the college I-card with his/her person.

#### **Fees Structures :--**

2. Fee of Second Term :-- Rs. 805/-
3. Retest Fees per paper is Rs. :-- 50/-
4. University Annual Examination Fees in Rs. :-- 100/-

The given fees amount is as per the us year and is liable to change as per the liable rules. Girl students and reserved category students are must required to pay Education fees as per the given rules.

#### **Examination :--**

1. It is Compulsory to appear in the Internal Examination conducted by the college and the University Examination.

3. Minimum required parsing Marks/ Percentage :-  
Internal – 11/30  
University – 25/70  
In S.Y.B.Com. the marks of the main / principal subjects Advanced accountancy paper 2 and paper 3 are calculated together. The minimum required parsing marks for which are as under.  
Internal – 22/60  
University – 50/100  
In case the student obtains less marks than the minimum passing marks then he/she will have to appear in the exam of both paper 4 and paper 5.
4. If the student obtains less than the required minimum marks in the Internal exam conducted by the college, it is called Internal Fail.
5. If he/she obtains less than 25 marks in the University Examination it is called External Fail.
6. If the Student in Internal Fail, then she/he is required to compulsorily appear in the University Exam of the subjects in which he/she is Internal fail.
7. It is compulsory for the Internal Fail Student to appear in the First and the second test of the college.
8. Those students who are declared fail in the University Examination cannot appear in the Examination conducted in the month of October-November. Such students can appear in the exam conducted by the University in the months of March-April. The forms for this exam are available in the month of December. (Keep an eye on the notice board.)
